

# **How to Log in to the Assessment**




9 After answering the last question, the Next button takes you to the Review page.

Note: You can navigate back to unanswered or flagged questions from the Review page.




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The review screen (on the Review page) is presented at the end of the assessment, even if all items have been answered. In this review screen, we see two unanswered questions (questions 13 and 14). You can also see that question 14 has been flagged by the student. You can select any item number and review the item before submitting the assessment. More information about flagged items can be found on the table on page 9.

Select the **Finish** button to submit the assessment.








# **Tools Available During the Assessment**

There are many tools available to assist you during the test. Not all are available for all tests. The applicable tools will be reviewed prior to the start of the test.








The question navigation is displayed at the bottom of the page.

You may move forward through the questions by selecting the **Next** button.

You can move to previous questions using the back arrow button.



The **Pause** button allows you to "pause" your test session. This should be used when you need to leave your workstation momentarily. The proctor is notified when your test is paused.



You will see the RESUME button once you select the pause button. To resume the assessment, you should select the RESUME button.



The accessibility menu option gives you the option to

- Change the color of the background and text.
- Change the font size.
- Read the instructions for using built-in browser zoom.



Flag Item	If you set a flag on a question, the lockdown browser displays it on the Review page. It is reminding you to look again at this question. In this example, question 1 is flagged.  Review  2
■ Unflag item	You can remove the flag by selecting <b>Unflag item</b> .
Response Masking	When response masking is on, answer options can be shaded on the screen to help you think through your response. Mask an answer option by selecting it. To remove the masking, you select the answer option again.
Highlight •	Apply highlighting to a section of text by first selecting the text, then choosing the highlight color using the pop-up Highlight drop-down menu.
Remove	After highlighting text, the highlight can be removed by first selecting the highlighted text. Then select the remove option from the pop-up.
7 Text to Speech	When Text to Speech (TTS) is enabled, this option toggles the TTS player (found at the top of the page) on and off. Only students with an assigned accessibility tool will be able to use TTS for the Science Assessment.






The text to speech player enables features for TTS.

<b>(3)</b>	Select to collapse or expand the TTS toolbar.
	Select to start TTS, then select anywhere in the text to start reading aloud.
	Speak (read aloud) the current selection.
II	Pause speech.
	Stops speech playback.
